


2024 FINANCES



IN AUGUST 2024, THE SURGEON GENERAL ISSUED AN ADVISORY HIGHLIGHTING:

- "1) THE STRESSORS THAT IMPACT THE MENTAL HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF **PARENTS AND CAREGIVERS**
- 2) THE CRITICAL LINK BETWEEN PARENTAL MENTAL HEALTH AND CHILDREN'S **LONG-TERM WELL-BEING**
- 3) THE URGENT NEED TO BETTER SUPPORT PARENTS, CAREGIVERS, & FAMILIES."

THE SURGEON GENERAL'S SURVEY INDICATED THAT THIS POPULATION OF PARENTS AND CAREGIVERS OF CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS REPORTED TWICE THE AMOUNT OF "FAIR OR POOR MENTAL HEALTH"

COMPARED TO PARENTS AND CAREGIVERS OF CHILDREN WITHOUT SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS.

AN ARTICLE IN THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF PEDIATRICS (2023) NOTED: "IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT HOME- AND HOSPITAL-BASED STAFF AND PROVIDERS. THROUGH COORDINATED AND FAMILY-CENTERED CARE. PARTNER WITH FAMILIES TO ASSESS SUPPORT AND INFORMATION NEEDS AND IDENTIFY OPPORTUNITIES TO HELP FAMILIES GENERATE LONG-LASTING NETWORKS OF SUPPORT BEYOND THE HOSPITAL WALLS."

C.I.T.Y. OF SUPPORT IS UNIQUELY POSITIONED TO ADDRESS THIS NEED.





WHAT'S NEXT FOR C.I.T.Y?

OVER 100 PARENTS RESPONDED TO OUR SURVEY:





93% AGREE/STRONGLY AGREE

94% AT LEAST 1X/MONTH

- "This is a fantastic idea! It's so hard to make adult friends as a parent with our kids. I would love to be able to connect with others that have similar struggles that I could hang out with and foster a friendship."
- "This would be a dream come true and everything I have been searching for!"
- "It would be life-changing. Being a parent is lonely, being a parent of a kid who is different is so isolating that it's nearly impossible to socialize. My kids are isolated."
- "I would love something like this. As my daughter's disease progresses I no longer feel that our favorite play places are meant for us. Having somewhere we can go that is specifically for children with disabilities and their families would be so meaningful!"
- "It sounds amazing! Nothing like this, only sporadic events and really no place for respite."

PHASE 1:



ESTABLISH A PHYSICAL PRESENCE

MAKE A FOOTPRINT THAT BUILDS OUR CAPACITY TO SERVE C.I.T.Y. OF SUPPORT & THE COMMUNITY

- INCREASE VISIBILITY AND AWARENESS FOR OUR ORGANIZATION
 - Provide a destination where doctors/schools can refer <u>caregivers</u> for support as they simultaneously refer children for therapy services.
 - Create an internal database of C.I.T.Y. families to cater our resources and offerings based on specific interests/needs.
- SUSTAIN REVENUE TO SUPPORT PROGRAMMING WITH A RESALE TOY STORE, MULTI-PURPOSE ROOMS, & PARENT LOUNGE:
 - Design a fun, multi-use space that uses our knowledge of play and learning to create a niche store where everyone in the community can shop and donate gently-used toys & materials.
 - Create a space that welcomes, acknowledges, & represents ALL children's needs.
 - Generate additional revenue by offering structured child/family classes in the multipurpose rooms and by selling snacks in the lounge.
- GROW OUR NETWORK OF VOLUNTEERS TO BEGIN OFFERING PROGRAMING SPECIFICALLY TO CHILDREN IN THERAPY AND THEIR FAMILIES.
 - Recruit college students & professionals to lead structured classes and provide lessstructured childcare supervision.
 - Provide a separate space for children to play together in this supervised environment, allowing parents to enjoy time together, either shopping in the store, relaxing in the lounge, or attending other small-scale educational/social events on-site.
- <u>DEVELOP EVENTS AND OPPORTUNITIES THAT BRING ALL CHILDREN AND FAMILIES</u> TOGETHER IN A DYNAMIC COMMUNITY.
- <u>SUPPORT ONGOING VOLUNTEERING, OUTREACH, & FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITIES FOR</u> MANY ORGANIZATIONS IN OUR COMMUNITY.

PHASE 2:



CREATE A COMMUNITY CENTER

CREATE A DESTINATION FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN IN THERAPY, WHERE CHILDREN AND CAREGIVERS ARE SUPPORTED ON THEIR JOURNEY

- CONSOLIDATE THE FUNDING WE HAVE RECEIVED FROM THE RESALE STORE (AND CONTINUE TO GENERATE) IN ORDER TO IDENTIFY A LARGE SPACE IN THE COMMUNITY TO OPEN THE COMPREHENSIVE C.I.T.Y. WELCOME CENTER.
 - AMENITIES FOR KIDS: large motor gym, video game room, sensory room, arts & crafts room, birthday room
 - AMENITIES FOR PARENTS: parent lounge/cafe, library, individual quiet rooms, fitness equipment, large social rooms, classroom
- COMPILE THE SKILLS, METRICS, VOLUNTEERS, AND CONNECTIONS WE HAVE DEVELOPED OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS TO DETERMINE OPTIMAL LOCATION, DESIGN, OFFERINGS, AND SUSTAINING FORMS OF REVENUE TO SUPPORT THE CENTER.
- INTRODUCE A SPACE FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN IN THERAPY THAT SUPPORTS THE NEEDS OF THEIR KIDS WHILE <u>ALSO</u> SUPPORTING THE NEEDS OF CAREGIVERS IN AN INCLUSIVE, WELCOMING, ONE-OF-A-KIND FACILITY. REPLICATIONS OF THIS MODEL IN OTHER COMMUNITIES CAN ALSO BE CONSIDERED.
